



Knitting pattern | KID'S BEANIE N#1

Size: Head circumference approx. 40 cm

Needle play: Nr. 3.5 – 4 (crochet hook Nr. 3)

Yarn: Pamir Fine Fibers SUPERIOR cashmere,
1 ball of 25 g (shown here in the color carbon)

Pattern 1:

1st round or needle: knit all sts

2nd round or needle: knit 1 st, purl 1 st

Repeat round or needles 1 and 2

Pattern 2:

knitt all sts

Swatch: 46 rounds and 22 sts = 10 cm



Knitting instructions:

First, 2 ear flaps are knitted

Cast on 5 sts, cast on 1 st 9 times on both sides of the front at the edges of the flap
= 23 sts and approx. 6 cm high

Cap rim

cast on 7 sts, cast off the 1st ear flap, cast on 28 sts, cast off the 2nd ear flap,

cast on 7 sts = total 88 sts

Close these sts to form a round

Start with round 1 of the knitting pattern 1 and knit approx. 10 cm high

Decrease

In pattern 2

Decrease round: *6 sts, 2 sts together*, from * repeat

An intermediate round (without decreasing)

Decrease round: *5 sts, 2 sts together*, from * repeat

An intermediate round (without decreasing)

The number of slip stitches in the decrease rounds is always reduced by 1 stitch

When there are no more slip stitches, continue with 2 stitches together until approx. 5 stitches remain. Pick up these sts with a wool needle and pull them together

Finish

Crochet around the edge, twist 2 cords and sew to the ear flaps

For a newborn, reduce the cast-on sts to 80 and knit only 8 cm until decreasing
